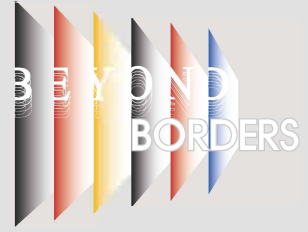

The 140th Anniversary of Korea-Germany Diplomatic Relations **The 140 Years Korean-German Partnerships Conference**

We are pleased to announce the 140 Years Korean-German Partnerships Conference, coinciding with the 140th anniversary celebration of Korea-Germany diplomatic ties, will take place on September 19, 2023 (Tuesday) in Seoul.

Established in 2006 with the support of the German Embassy, ADeKo (Alumninetzwerk Deutschland-Korea; Alumni Network Germany-Korea) is a registered non-profit corporation under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. It was founded with the aim of expanding mutual understanding and collaboration between Korea and Germany by enhancing cooperation and contributing to the substantive development of both societies. ADeKo primarily focuses on over 20,000 Korean alumni who have studied in Germany, and it also opens its doors to the approximately 110,000 employees of the 540 German companies operating in Korea anyone interested in Korea and Germany.

This year's the 140 Years Korean-German Partnerships Conference holds significant meaning as it is jointly organized by both countries to commemorate the 140th anniversary of Korea-Germany diplomatic relations. Around 300 participants, including academics, officials, and corporate representatives from both Korea and Germany, are expected to attend. This special event aims to discuss the future collaboration and development between the two nations, providing a valuable opportunity for ADeKo members, experts from various fields, and professionals to engage in active scholarly exchanges and share their diverse experiences.
